The Noyer-Wildhagen House

Front 3 floors and the commanding original entry of this grand Federal home, built in 1807 and converted into condos in 1985.

Historic architectural details seamlessly blend with modern conveniences. The first level is an open floor plan great room with a modern kitchen. Tall ceilings and windows bathe the space in natural sunlight. A graceful staircase brings you the second floor and the original formal drawing room with significant historic woodwork and black marble fireplace surround. The third floor greets you with an impressive fanlight window with views of St. Phillip's steeple. Each room has a gas log fireplace. One off-street parking space is included.
